

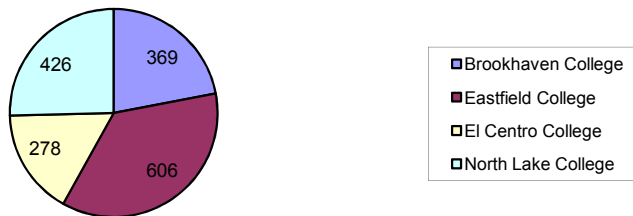

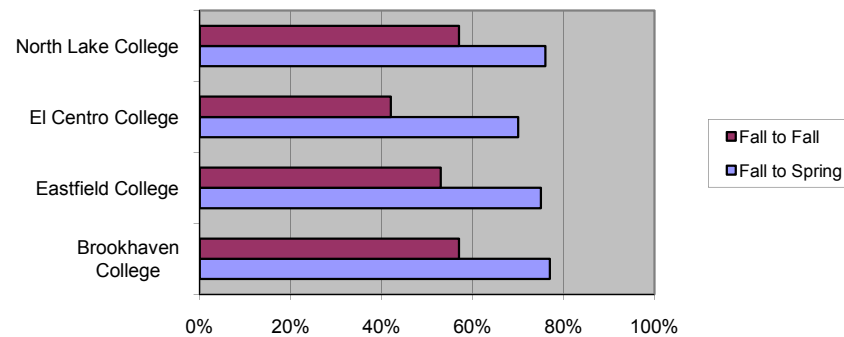

1st-yr Retention Rate



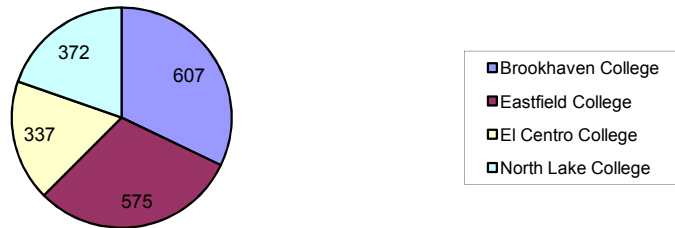

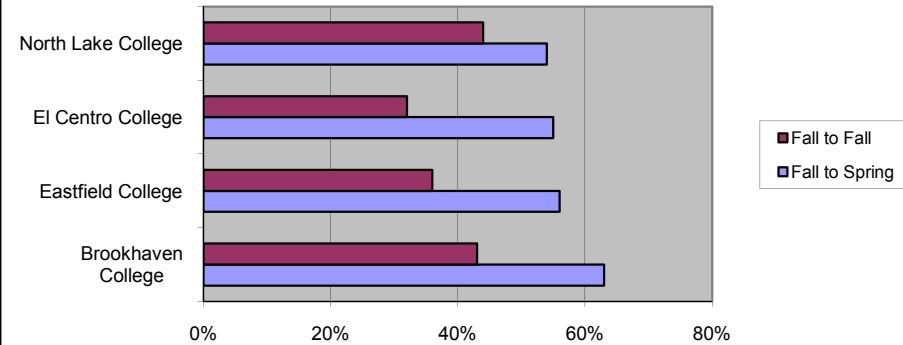

1st-yr Retention Rate



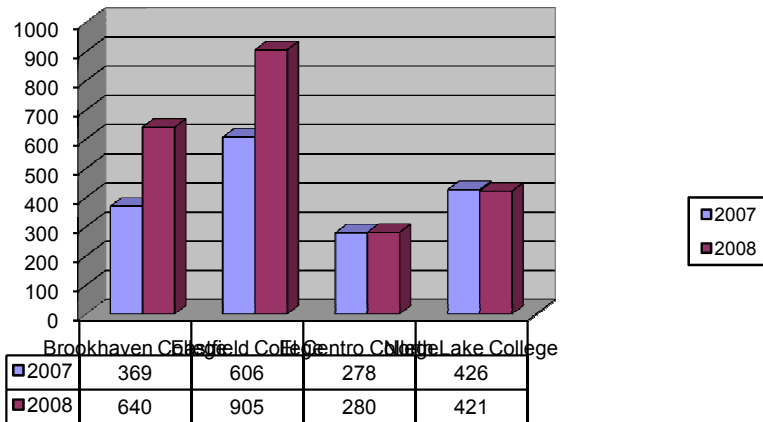

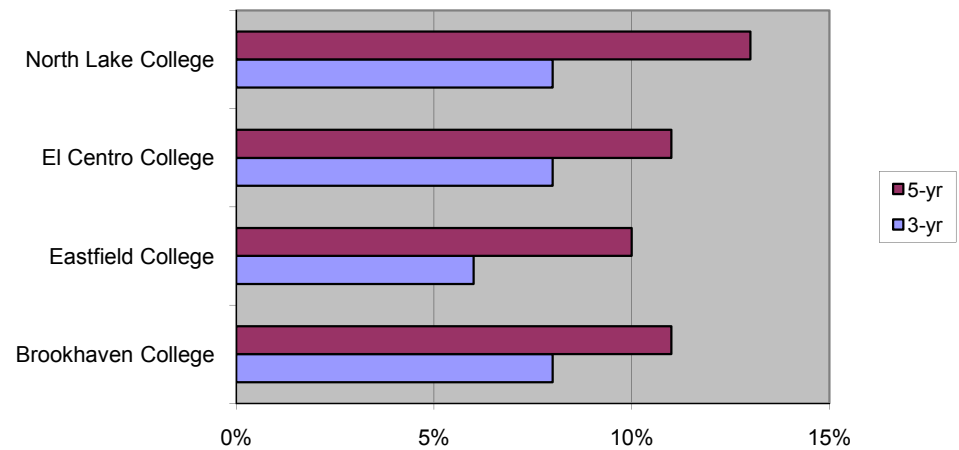

**Graduation Rates**



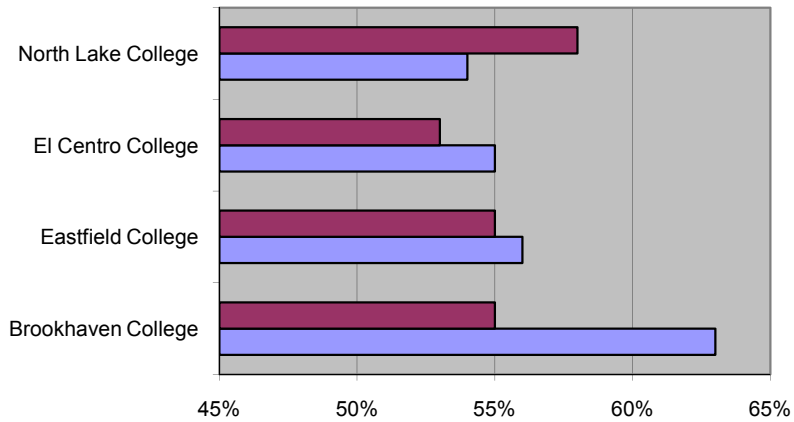
