PROBLEM ANALYSIS
 ---About 60% of
**incoming freshman have
 not overcome basic skill
 deficiencies after a year.**
 ---Nearly 40% of first-
 time, fulltime freshman
 students were not
 retained to their second
 year, and of those were
 still enrolled, 31% were
**NOT in *Good Academic
 Standing*.**
