**COURSEWORK FROM FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES**

Science and math courses completed at colleges and universities outside the United States may be considered for transfer toward a health occupations program. Examples include sciences courses such as anatomy, physiology, microbiology, chemistry, physics, and general biology and must include a laboratory component. Math courses must be college level algebra or calculus. No other courses will be considered for transfer credit. Science courses are subject to the five year time limit.

The following material must be presented to the Health Occupations Admissions Office:

- Official college transcript with English translation (if applicable).

Original course-by-course evaluation of the official transcripts by an approved evaluation agency. (A list of approved evaluation agencies is available at all DCCCD Registrar's Offices and at <http://www.dcccd.edu/Employees/Departments/EA/TS/forStudents/Pages/ForCredEvals.aspx>)

- A photocopy of the official course description or syllabus of each science or math course to be reviewed.

**NOTE:** The review of foreign course work is usually completed within 10-14 working days. However, during peak times such as college registration or after the close of the semester when faculty are unavailable, the review may take as long as 30 days to complete. Therefore, it is to the applicant's advantage to request any course evaluation at their earliest convenience prior to application to a health occupations program.
