## NEXT STEP AND MOVING ON

Classes specifically designed for students with developmental and learning disabilities. Intended to prepare students for work by teaching interpersonal skills, basic work related academic and computer skills, and work readiness skills such as how to get and keep a job.

### The Next Step and Moving On Classes:

These course offerings are designed for students with developmental disabilities or difficulties learning in traditional settings. The focus is on improving work related reading and communication skills, learning basic computer skills, and developing employment and job search skills.

Personal Social Adjustment classes target improving ability to demonstrate skills in decision making, goal setting, assertiveness, career development and enhancement, anger management, conflict resolution, and applying strategies of adjustment in his or her life.

Beginning Computer classes target improving understanding of computer applications specific to business-related software and emphasizes concurrent development of office skills and computer
